## **CHLORINATING YOUR WELL/SPRING**

- 1. Locate well casing or collection box.
- 2. Add ½ gallon of household bleach to shallow well or collection box; or 1 gallon to deep well (over 100' deep). Measurements may vary depending on size and depth of well.
- 3. If possible, use garden hose attached to outside faucet, (same water system). Place hose 2' into well casing and turn on water. This is to re-circulate the chlorinated water. Do this for about 1 hour. If you cannot use a hose, mix the bleach in 5 gallons of water and pour into the well.
- 4. Remove the hose and replace the lid with sanitary seal. Check for cracks. Turn off outside hose.
- 5. Go into home and turn on all faucets until you smell chlorine.
- 6. Turn off faucets and allow chlorine to sit in lines for a minimum of 8 hours which is contact time to kill bacteria.
- 7. After contact time, flush out chlorine THOROUGHLY by running water for 3 to 4 hours onto the grass. DO NOT run through the house into the septic system. Then turn on home faucets for 5 to 10 minutes allowing chlorine to flush out of the faucets. Caution: Not completely flushing out chlorine may cause health effects or bleach out laundry.
- 8. Wait 4 days and re-test water.
