INTRODUCTION

This directory is intended to promote mental wellbeing. This content is being provided as a convenience and for informational purposes only; they do not constitute an endorsement or an approval by the Bear River Health Department. Always verify information listed with that specific agency.

Uninsured and in Crisis?

Anyone experiencing a mental health crisis has access to crisis services through Bear River Mental Health, regardless of insurance status or inability to pay.

Call 435-752-0750, and be sure to say you are "in a crisis" to access services.

There are also many other resources in this directory that have options for uninsured individuals.

Insurance

Private Insurance: This includes most insurance companies.

Some providers can only bill select insurance companies. Contact your insurance company to verify mental health benefits and in-network providers. In addition, most provider's offices are happy to assist you with billing questions.

<u>Medicaid</u>: This is state & federal sponsored insurance. Medicaid is an assistance program. It serves low-income people of every age. Patients usually pay no part of costs for covered medical expenses. A small co-payment is sometimes required. Medicaid is a federal-state program. It varies from state to state.

Medicare: A federal insurance program that primarily serves people over the age of 65, whatever their income. It also serves younger disabled individuals and dialysis patients. Patients pay part of costs through deductibles for hospital and other costs. Small monthly premiums are required for non-hospital coverage.

Uninsured: These are individuals who have no health insurance.

<u>Underinsured</u>: This includes individuals who do not have mental health benefits or adequate mental health coverage.

Behavioral Health Network

Uninsured or underinsured individuals might qualify to receive psychotherapy or substance abuse treatment through the Behavioral Health Network. Contact the social worker at the Logan Regional Hospital Behavioral Health Unit at 435-716-5602 to learn more. This is a confidential line and voicemails are accepted.
